The competition will be held on Roller City's super fast 75' X 160' rotunda hardwood maple floor with a fresh coat of Sika WP-8 plastic applied just before the meet. Sanctioned by USA Roller Sports, The 2016 'Wichita Winter Classic' will skate all Standard and Novice events including all races in each division. 2 & 4 Person Relays will be skated as well as Open Events on the 100 meter Oval Track (NIRA).

Special for this year - Quad Events for both Boys & Girls - Juvenile 9 & Under, Freshman 10-13. Senior 14 & Older, Masters 35 & Older. Distances will be the same as Novice B Division Distances

Large, Beautiful Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third placements in all Standard (Elite) Divisions, Novice Divisions and Relays. Beautiful trophies will be awarded to the top five placements each Open Race. High Point Trophies will be awarded to the top three Teams. The 2016 'Wichita Winter Classic' will also provide the very best officials to officiate the meet.

'Challenge Ups' and Special "Race of Champions" for Men and Ladies: Standard Elite Skaters only may challenge up one Standard Elite Division provided they skate their regular Standard Elite Division. (a Sophomore skater may challenge up and skate Junior). The top three placements from the 'Standard Elite' Sophomore, Junior, Senior Divisions and top placement from Freshman and Classic Divisions (up to 11 total skaters) will compete in a special 2500 meter Race of Champions for the Crystal Cup.

#### \*\*\*\*\* IMPORTANT NOTICE \*\*\*\*\*

- 1. Standard Skaters may Challenge Up one division from their age division, Classic & older may Challenge Down one division. Skaters must skate their regular division.
- 2. Novice Skaters may enter their regular Standard (Elite) Division but not allowed to Challenge Up.
- 3. Novice 'B' Skaters may enter their regular Novice Division but are not allowed to Challenge Up.
- 4. Divisions and Relay Events with less than three entries may be combined at the Meet Directors discretion. All combined Events will be awarded separately. Heats may be shortened due to time restraints.
- 5. **Bonus Race Skaters in divisions with heats** will qualify for the Long Race Final (Bonus Race) by qualifying 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in either the short or middle distance heats. No heats will be skated for the long race. **If a division does not have heats every skater will skate the Bonus Race.**
- 6. Open Races are open to all Novice 'B', Novice and Standard (Elite) Skaters. Skaters will use a rolling start and will draw for their starting position. Lap Rule will be in effect down to six skaters remaining in the race. Awards for the top five placements.
- 7. There is no challenging up in Relay Events, Relay skaters are required to skate their proper age division.
- 8. Skaters who do not have relay partners may enter the relays (2 person & 4 person) as a draw. Teams will be made up using a deck of cards. **Indicate all draws on the entry.**
- 9. Entry Cap for individual skaters and familys. Skaters may enter all events they are eligible (max 7) for \$60.00 or a family of 3 or more skaters may skate all events they are eligible (max 7 each skater) for \$150.00
